


unit 185 DIN bhpl in the S. up to 37.5 mpa overall touring consumption.

Electronic lanition.

We haven't stopped with just fuel economy, however,

Alpine Comfort.

All too often, if you want a lot of economy, you have to economise on other things, like comfort and equipment.

Not so with the new Alpine. Cloth upholstered seats for five people are the last word in relaxation. Fully reclining at front. Soft yet support-giving all round.

Carpeting goes farther than door-to-door in the S; it's even on the doors themselves.

The heating and ventilation system is entirely new. There are four adjustable face level vents on the fascia, two for cold air and two for air at the selected temperature (the former are also very efficient side window demisters). Warm air is fed through the footwells and in the S, individual vents are provided for rear seat passengers.

The Alpine's aerodynamic shape is not only attractive to look at, it's the result of exhaustive wind tunnel testing, to reduce wind resistance and noise. We've added sound proofing inside, and the fascia, engine, and fully independent all-round suspension are insulated to ensure that your ride is as quiet and smooth as possible.

full underbody sealing, as well as protecting the bodywork, adds to the quiet ride.

Driver Comfort.

As far as equipment is concerned, everything you'll need is set out clearly and within easy reach. The soft rim steering wheel with its close-set twin spokes gives the clearest possible view of the instruments, and there are controls for 2-speed wipers with flick wipe, 4-jet electric screen wash, heated rear window, reversing lights and rear fog lamp, and hozard warning flashers.

The GL has two large circular instrument dials, with speedometer and petrol/temperature gauges, and the S has, in addition, dials for

tachometer, oil pressure and clock, with a row of warning lights for handbrake, low oil pressure, side lights, direction indicators, main beam, alternator charge and low fuel level.

Switches in the central panel have a two-level lighting system. One indicates their location. The other, their on position and functioning for easy identification in night driving. Heater controls are also illuminated.

Alpine Versatility.

The new Alpine gives you the best of both worlds. With the back seat in position, there's plenty of space for five people. And 10.7 cu. ft. of luggage space underneath the useful rear parcel shelf.

But if you want to convert some of that passenger space into extra luggage space, nothing could be easier.

The parcel shelf folds up and comes out, to be neatly held in place by its retaining clip. And clips behind

the rear seat let you fold it flat without scrambling into the back or through the side doors.

In a matter of seconds, you've got 49 cu. ft. of space and nearly six feet from behind the front seats to the big rear opening door, which is supported by twin gas-filled struts for easy lifting.

If you want a car that you can really get the most out of, the new Alpine is what you want. It's what versatility is all about.

Alpine Safety.

At Chrysler, we've gone to great lengths to give you a car with all the safety features necessary for today's motoring conditions.

The entire passenger compartment, for instance, is of unitary construction for extra strength. This strength has been concentrated in the floor, sills, and centre section, so that pillars can be as thin as possible to give all round vision.

The nose and tail sections have been designed so that, in the event of an accident, passengers have the maximum protection.

Front and rear bumpers which wrap round as far as the wheel arches are a new concept in car protection, designed to meet European regulations.

Steering incorporates 'centre point steering geometry 'to reduce steering wheel reaction from bad roads. Servo-assisted front disc and rear drum brakes have separate circuits, connected to a warning lamp and test button. And the transverse mounted engine gives superb manoeuvrability, handling, cornering and roadholding.

Both models have big rectangular headlights (halogen on the SI which are adjustable to compensate for the load you're carrying.

Inside, the safety features

continue, with a safety steering column and heavily padded steering wheel, anti-burst childproof door locks and dipping rear view mirror.

How we developed the carthat gives you everything.

When we first started planning the new Alpine, we set down the following main objectives:

Our new car had to be a "European car"; that is, one that incorporated the features in increasing demand by buyers in every European country: like front wheel drive and five doors.

It had to have a classic, sophisticated shape and appearance that would look modern for years.

The highest standards of comfort and space were also necessary. As well as maximum possible quietness, performance, roadholding and, of course, economy.

After our designers had received the objectives, they developed four different themes for discussion, from which, two themes 2 and 4, were further refined for final selection. The bacit skyling of theme 2 was selected and combined with an outstanding feature of theme 4, which was a new concept in car protection; a separate reinforced resin bumper which apparent completely integrated, but was isolated from the body which if protected. As a result, the car meets European regulations which state that a car must be able to sustain a corner impact at 2½ mph, without damage to the bodywork or lights.

The next stage was a series of wind tunnel tests. Modifications to surface contours and careful design of front pillars ensured that the airlive over the bonnet and roof and down the back of the car would be as smooth as possible. Thus minimising the turbulence which causes fouling of the rear window, and reducing wind noise. So you'll find that even in the rain, Alpina's big rear window stays clear, and that inside the car (if is surripingly quiet. After the wind tunnel, more design work. Further adjustment gave maximum interior width and the smoothest possible surface continuity free glass to metal, providing a clean, unbroken body shape. All round visibility was closely looked at, and so pilliars and waistline the line dividing the windows from the doors! were carefully developed to ensure as much glass area as possible within the stringent soften parameter.

Interior styling and design had to meet European safety standards, as well as giving a high level of driver and passenger comfort. Driver's reach was examined, so were instrument and overall vision requirements. Studies showed that instruments with clear, bold characters were best, both for efficiency and eesthetically. Warning lights with international symbols, and instrumentation in general, are very much driver orientated. Even the steering wheel is the result of intensive research. The all-new two spacke design provides driver comfort, easy operation and superb reading of the dials.

Chrysler's world-wide knowledge was of great help in the design and development of seating. Seat positions were determined only after exhaustive testing; for both front and rear comfort under all conditions, and to provide effective stow-away for the rear seat to give maximum load corrying appacity.

Working with the designers at this stage were colour and fabric experts from all over Europe.


Selection and keying of exterior and interior colours, trims, fabrics and carpeting, required considerable expertise to achieve the correct balance. The result is an interior that is both attractive and functional.

That, in a very tiny nutshell, is the story of the new Alpine. Although we've talked mainly about design here, obviously, Chrysler Engineering worked closely with the design team and played a massive part in the development. Many of their results are described elsewhere in this brochure.


