The MT75 five-speed manual gearbox embodies a wealth of modern technology, and provides synchromesh on reverse gear. Its robust yet lightweight construction contributes to driveline efficiency, and it is perfectly matched to Ford's powerful, high-torque engines.

Ford's advanced 2.0 EFI engine has DOHC configuration, and delivers outstanding power with exceptional smoothness and flexibility. Whether running on unleaded fuel, or specified with a catalyst, it will help protect the environment.

There are now Granada and Scorpio models powered by engines equipped with three-way catalytic converters. These engines also have electronic engine management (EEC IV) and electronically controlled fuel injection systems, and must run only on unleaded petrol. They are also designed to ensure that the fuel/air mixture is blended as completely and as rapidly as possible, providing more complete combustion characteristics. Three-way catalytic converters contain a highly complex ceramic core with a special coating which is the result of advanced technology. On contact with the coating, most of the undesirable constituents of exhaust gas are transformed into chemical elements which occur naturally in our atmosphere. In all these ways and others, Ford is demonstrating its concern for the environment.

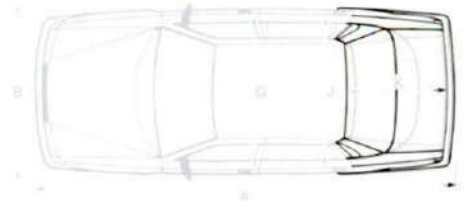
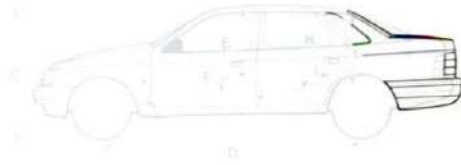
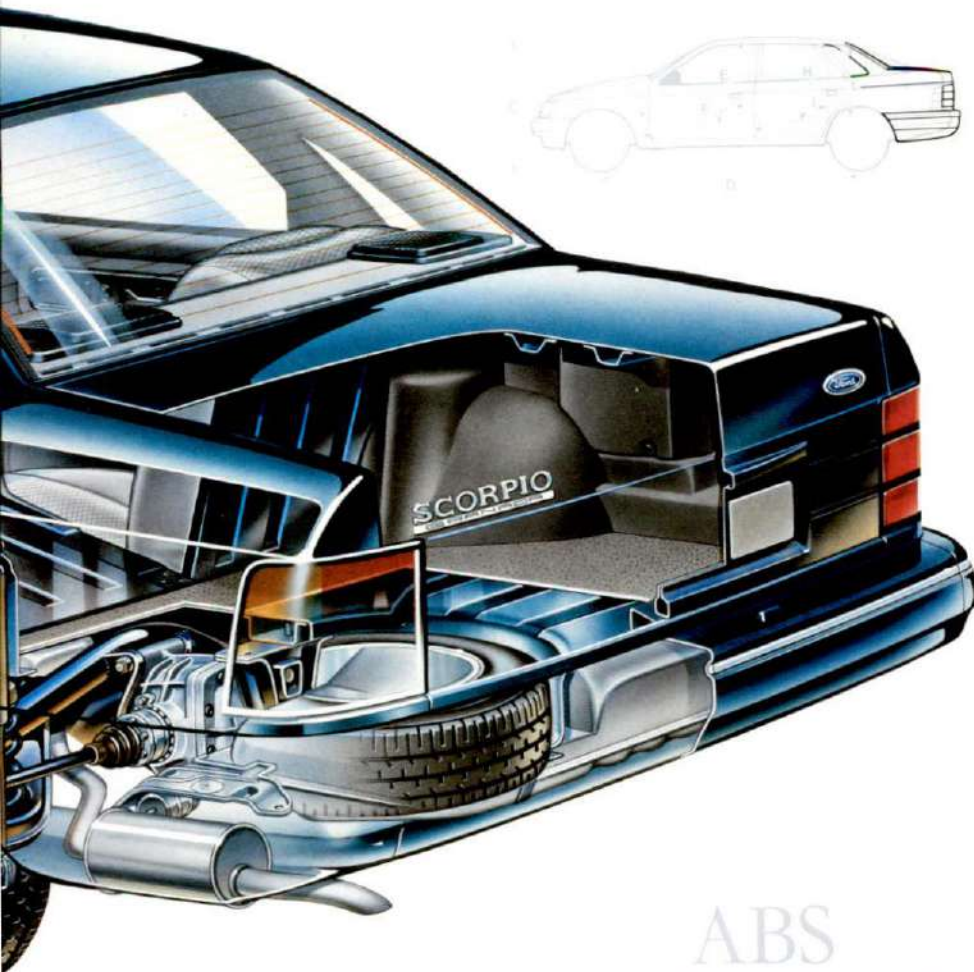
The luxurious Granada and Scorpio are environment-friendly in operation. As with all Ford models, their petrol engines run on '95' Octane unleaded fuel, without adjustment and there are now selected Ghia and Scorpio models equipped with three-way catalytic converters.



All Granada and Scorpio models are protected by 20-stage anti-corrosion treatment, for long-lasting bodywork.

The power-assisted steering system Ford provide as standard on all Granada and Scorpio models has variable rate action, which decreases the steering effort required with the amount of lock applied. It complements the electronic ABS anti-lock braking system - which Ford innovated as standard Granada and Scorpio equipment - to ensure full and effortless control.

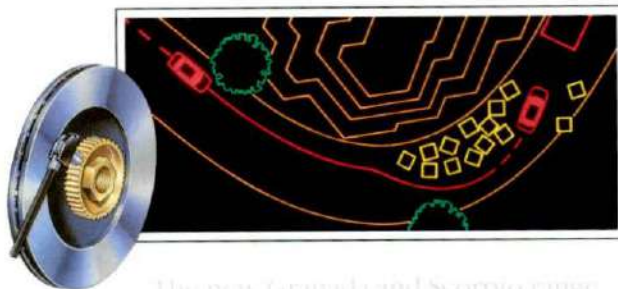

ABS

ABS braking uses electronics technology to detect impending wheel locking. The brakes are then pulsed to provide retardation without locking.



The new Granada and Scorpio range have a revised rear suspension arrangement for rear wheel drive models, which eliminates the need for a rear stabiliser bar. It also enables the rear end of the car to sit lower than on the previous range with benefits in comfort, handling and stability particularly when changing lanes at speed.



Both 4-door and 5-door Granada and Scorpio designs provide generous loadspace. The 5-door models offer 0.439 cubic metres (m³) with the rear seat in position, and 1.351 m³ with the rear seat folded down, whilst the 4-door model's boot holds 0.490 m³. This can be extended still further by using the 60:40 split-fold rear seat-back.

Granada and Scorpio four-door models provide exceptional boot space, with the added security of a lock which can be isolated from the central locking system. The seat back retaining catches can also be locked from inside the boot.

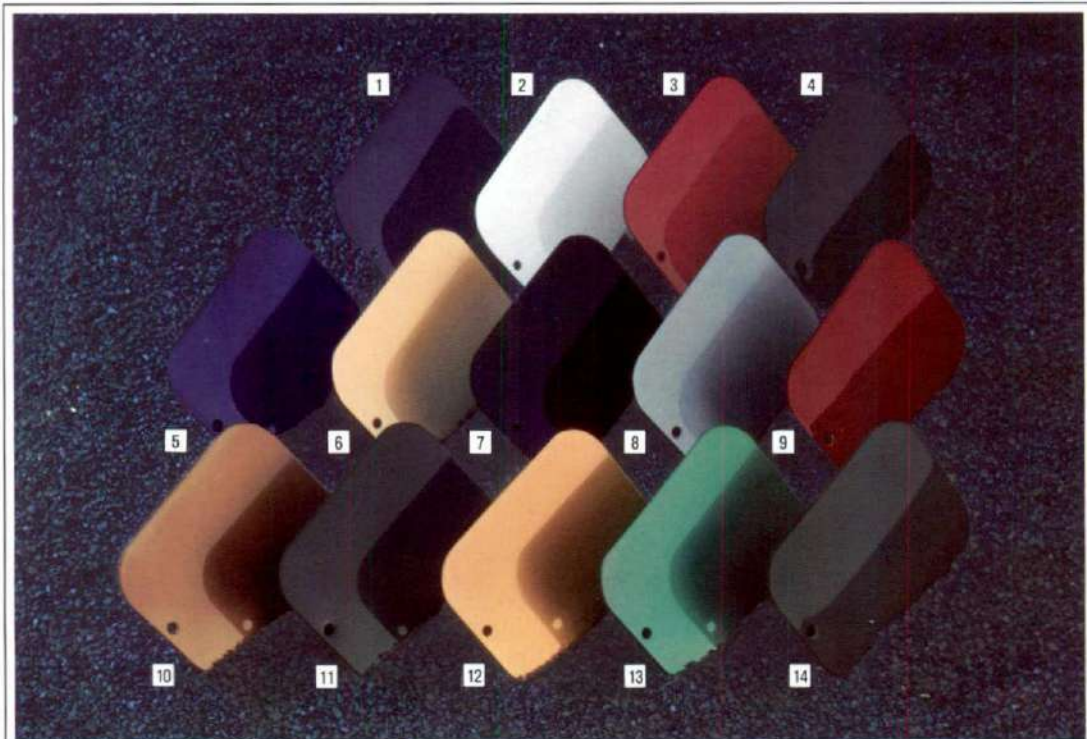
