



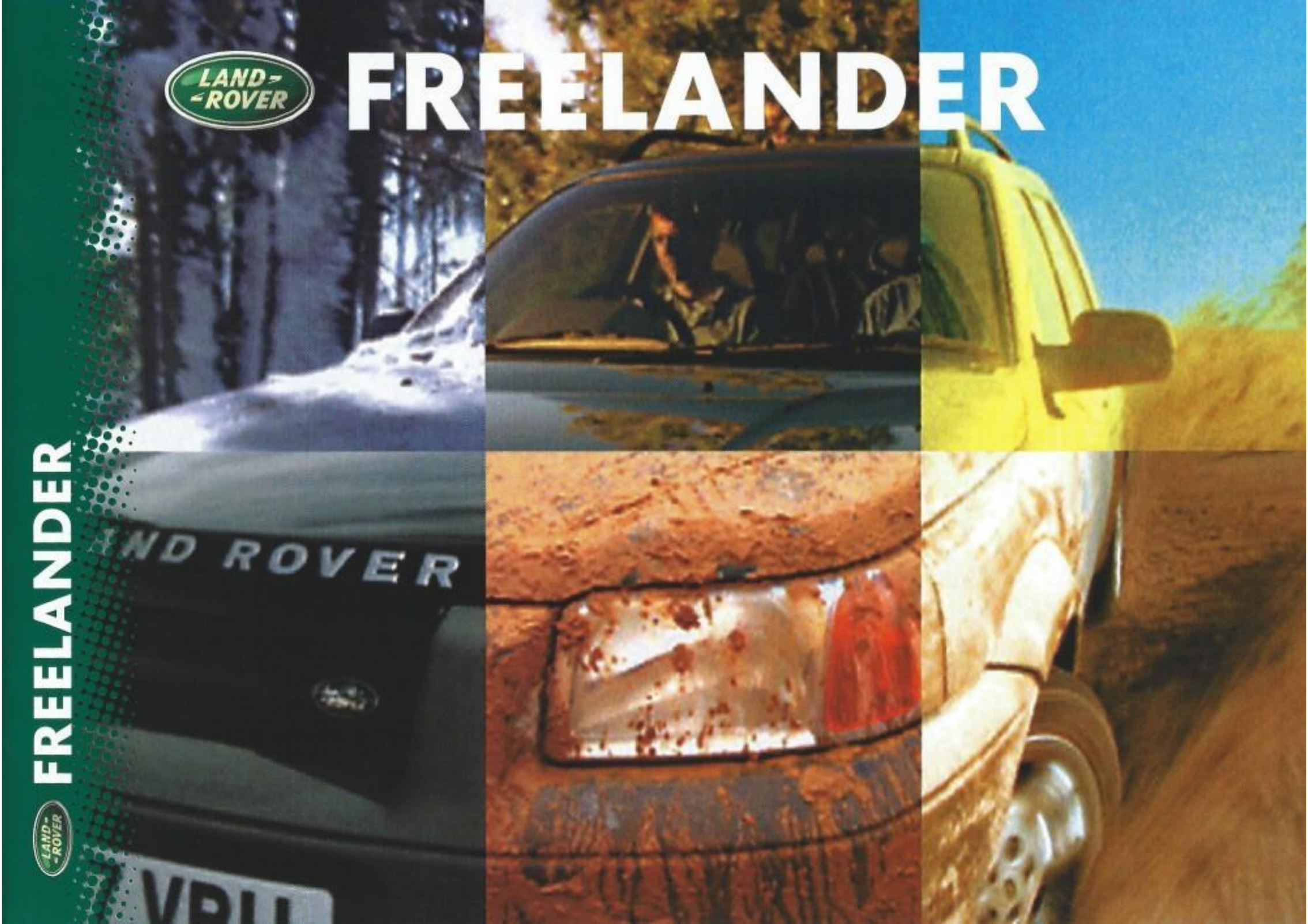

The rigid, integral chassis optimises stiffness whilst reducing vehicle weight and, combined with the low centre of gravity, enhances stability. All round independent suspension with long wheel travel allied to the power assisted rack and pinion steering, soaks up the roughest roads and eases Freelander around the corners without dulling the senses. Of course Freelander, like all Land Rover vehicles, is a permanent 4x4 but under normal road conditions most of the power is channelled through the front wheels. Should conditions change Freelander's ingenious viscous coupling progressively distributes power between the front and rear axles safely regaining grip. 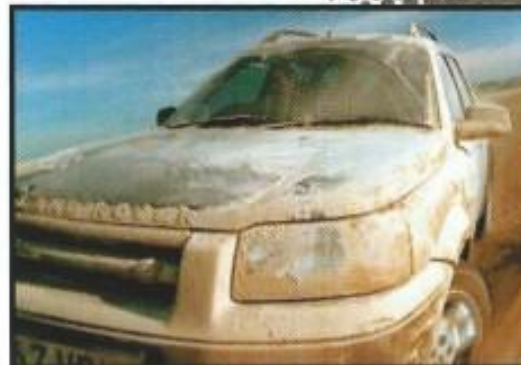
LAND ROVER OFF-ROAD CAPABILITY

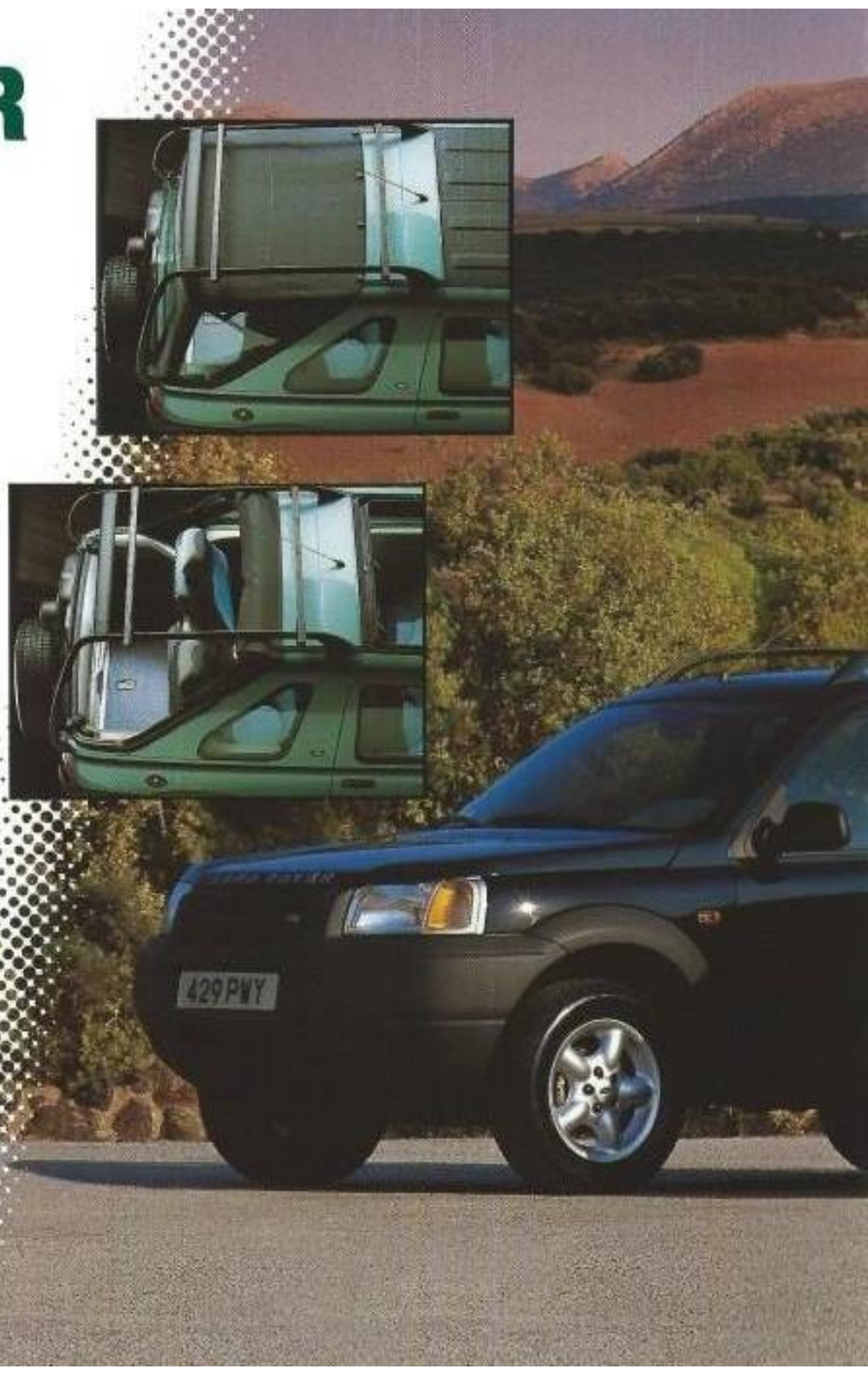

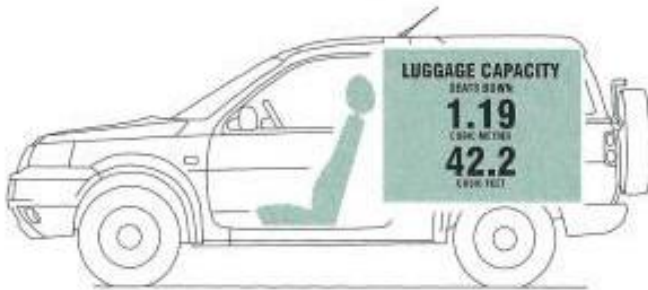
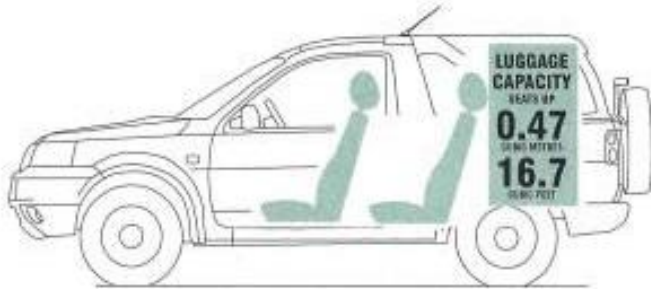
DESIGNED-IN COMFORT

Whether you're driving with or without a roof, carrying passengers, carrying loads – or carrying both, Freelander has the versatility to do it all.

The 3 door and 5 door models offer the same in legroom, interior spaciousness and commanding seating position giving you a view out over the madding crowd. The three door comes with four bucket seats with the rears folding forwards to increase luggage capacity. A split folding three person rear seat with three diagonal belts and head restraints is optional on three door and standard on five door with a rear centre armrest. Furthermore, Freelander's unique exterior styling is carried through to the interior design offering a choice of trim colours on the unique, extrovert 3 door package and a different more luxurious 5 door interior. Storage is superb with door bins, overhead cargo nets and even flexible drinks holder. Drivers airbag, power steering and electric windows, together with Freelander's unique electric tail door drop glass are standard on all models.

In addition to delivering improved fuel economy and reduced CO₂ emissions, the Freelander uses only water-based paints. Whilst providing the highest quality paint finish, the spraying process reduces solvent emissions by over 50%.

Ozone depleting gases such as CFCs and HCFCs have been eliminated from all vehicle components and production processes.

Freelander's manufacturing process improvements have resulted in 30% reductions in CO₂ emissions and 41% savings in water usage per vehicle. (Between 1991-1998).

The Freelander design has been improved to facilitate easier disassembly, materials recycling and fluid drainage.
