The exterior presence of the Flying Spur is complemented by the wide range of standard colours[†], while its distinctive alloy wheels and exclusive badges confirm that this motor car is among the rarest of the genre.



DISTINCTIVE REFINEMENT

Four-door, long-wheelbase saloon finished in a wide range of standard colours or a colour from the non-standard range at no extra cost. Interior trim features hide upholstery and headlining, and exclusive burr oak wood veneers with wrap-around, fully-veneered waist rails. Burr walnut veneer is available at no extra cost. Polished treadplates are fitted with a Flying Spur badge, as is the boot lid. As denoted by a veneered plaque, each motor car is individually numbered as one of a limited series. Electrically adjustable rear seats, illuminated picnic tables and remotely-controlled audio equipment contribute to a highlyappointed rear passenger area.

EXCLUSIVE PERFORMANCE

Superbly smooth, 6.7-litre turbocharged V8 engine with transient boost control, providing sparkling acceleration from 0-60mph (0-96kph) in 7 seconds and a top speed (where conditions allow) of 140mph (224kph). Four-speed fully automatic gearbox with shift energy management and final drive with a ratio of 2.28: 1. Revised suspension system with unique tuning of Adaptive Ride Control and purposeful air dam for high performance with poise. Fully powered anti-lock braking system. Distinctive alloy road wheels fitted with Rolls-Royce centre-piece and whitewall 255/65VR15 tyres.
