

Mention the name Cresta and what springs to mind? Space? Five people fit in very comfortably with all luggage stowed easily in the huge 30 cu ft (0.85 m²) trunk. Speed? Cresta passes you easily—but then just keeps on going. Comfort? Driver and passengers travel all day and still feel fresh. And there's

more than that.

Two versions to choose from-Cresta and Cresta de Luxe and both have detail improvements for 1971. Power and performance are similar for both models. Both have twin headlamps, a slim elegant grille badge and bright hub caps. In addition, Cresta de Luxe (as shown below), has bright wheeltrims and sill mouldings, bright mouldings on the rear wings and below the windows, and a de Luxe badge on the boot. Add the stylish, roomy body shape and you're sold – if you want a sedate carriage.

Now sit behind the wheel and

turn on the power. With extra sound insulation the engine seems only to whisper. Then through the gears and you're doing 60 mph in only 138 secs*-still only whispering. For a carriage that's anything but sedate. This 33 litre, six-cylinder engine is aggresively powerful, yet flexible enough to dawdle at "Autocar, 2.10.69 -Two-car Test"

under 20 mph in top gear. The car handles superbly at all speeds with light positive steering (finger touch if you have optional power-assisted steering), positive braking and excellent vision all round.

Inside everything is made for driver and passenger comfort. Full carpeting; door trims right up to glass level with map pockets in both front doors; and comfortable, safety-shaped armrests (rear door armrests have built-in ashtrays). Both models also boast a handsomely grained wooden facia complete with glovebox and ashtray. Cresta de Luxe also has a lockable glovebox lid and cigar lighter.

CRESTA DE LUXE BENCH SEAT

Feel the seats. Sink back into Cresta de Luxe's soft, resilient Ambla. A full-width de Luxe bench seat with centre armrest comes as standard. But you may choose individual front seats as a low-cost option. Or pay just a little extra and enjoy fully-reclining individual front seats-also trimmed in Ambla. All three seat styles are also available, at extra cost, in real leather.

In Cresta all upholstery is in Vynide. Both front and rear seats are comfortable, full width bench seats, contoured to prevent passengers sliding sideways when cornering—and each has a folding armrest.

With a car as quiet and as comfortable as Cresta you could easily forget the technicalities of driving—go where you like, when you like. So the controls are kept simple and all within easy reach, although there is everything you need to give you complete command. One of the twin circular dials incorporates a 120 mph

speedometer: the other shows clearly the fuel gauge, temperature gauge, ammeter, and ignition and oil pressure warning lights. Also clearly visible between the dials are warning lamps for turn indicators, headlamp main beam and (standard on Cresta de Luxe.

Heater/demister/ventilator and two-speed fan controls are placed in the centre of the facia, together with a cigar lighter (standard on Cresta de Luxe) and windscreen wipers/electric screen-

> clean control. A fresh air ventilator is mounted at each end of the facia.



Toggle switches for lights and heated rear window fall to hand right beside the instruments.

1971 Crestas offer a choice of two transmissions. Standard transmission is a four-speed manual gearbox, with a lift-up collar on the gearlever for engaging reverse. Optional at extra cost on both Cresta and Cresta de Luxe is the versatile and responsive GM Automatic transmission (said by *Autocar to be the finest European automatic they've tested). Both transmission selector levers are set in a floor-mounted console.

The Facts

Fuel capacity 15 gallons. (68-2 litres; 18 U.S. gallons.)

Suspension Front suspension. Independent front suspension with telescopic shock absorbers.

Rear suspension. Live rear axle with semi-elliptic leaf springs and telescopic shock absorbers. Rubber insulated control rod links axle housing with main frame side member.

Steering Recirculating ball. Ratio, 17.6 to 1. Steering wheel diameter, 16.5 in (419 mm). Turning circle diameter, 36.5 ft (11.25 m). New anti-penetration steering column. Power steering optional at extra cost.

Brakes Hydraulic, dual circuit brakes with vacuum-servo assistance. 10.5 in (267 mm) diameter discs at front, 9 in (229 mm) diameter, self-adjusting drum brakes at rear. Total swept area, 302 sq in (1948 cm²).

Wheels and tyres Five steel wheels with wellbase rims, $4.5J \times 14$. Tyres, tubeless, 5.90×14 , 4-ply rating. 7.00×14 nylon-ply tyres, for sustained high speed driving, optional at extra cost.

Electrical 12 volt, 55 amp/hour battery. Negative earth system. 35 amp alternator. Twin, two-speed, self-parking windscreen wipers. Twin 5.75 in (146 mm) headlamps. Floor-mounted dipswitch; main beam indicator light on instrument panel. Separate sidelights. Amber flashing indicators and headlamp flasher* combined in self-cancelling lever on steering column. Twin, matched-tone horns. Interior roof lamp with map

reading beam. Front (and rear*) door courtesy switches.

Cigarette lighter.* Automatic boot light.* Air blend type
heater/ventilator with de-icer and demister with 2-speed fan.
Thermal interrupter unit protects headlamps, side and tail lamps,
interior light and horn. Auxilliary circuits protected by a four-bank
fuse box.

Body Unitised, all-welded steel structure, containing box girder members with stressed skin panels for exceptional stiffness. Entire underbody and undersides of wings sealed with bituminous plastic. Vauxhall eight-stage rust and paint treatment with final coats of Magic Mirror acrylic lacquer – thermally reflowed to give a hard glazed surface.
